Agenda Title

Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Approval of Resolution No. 2022-27 Related to the November 8, 2022 Election for the Board of Directors.

Recommended Action

Approve draft Resolution No. 2022-27 ordering the Board of Directors elections on November 8, 2022 and direct the General Manager to provide these documents to the Contra Costa County Clerk/Recorder-Elections Department by July 13, 2022.

Executive Summary:

The Town of Discovery Bay Community Services District Board is comprised of five elected seats, three of which expire on December 1, 2022. Board President Kevin Graves and Directors Bryon Gutow and Ashley Porter occupy four-year terms that expire this year. The election for these seats will be held on November 8, 2022.

The District is required to adopt a resolution that orders the election and specifies that the election be consolidated and whether the candidates or the district will pay for the candidate statements.

As in previous District elections, the draft resolution specifies that candidates will pay for their statements. A 250-word limit is identified along with an estimated statement cost of \$353.76. Word limits may be higher if approved by the District and included in the Resolution. Word limits over 250 may have double the cost. The 250-word limit is the standard provided by the County Office of Elections. The Board may decide to have the District pay for the candidate statement.

The Resolution as approved will be forwarded to the County Elections Department by July 13, 2022.

RESOLUTION 2022-27

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE TOWN OF DISCOVERY BAY, A CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT, ORDERING SPECIFICATIONS OF THE ELECTION ORDER

WHEREAS, California Elections Code requires a general district election be held in each district to choose a successor for each elective officer whose term will expire on the first Friday in December following the election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November in each even-numbered year; and

WHEREAS, other elections may be held in whole or in part of the territory of the district and it is to the advantage of the district to consolidate pursuant to Elections Code Section 10400; and

WHEREAS, Elections Code Section 10520 requires each district involved in a general election to reimburse the county for the actual costs incurred by the county elections official in conducting the election for that district; and

WHEREAS, Elections Code Section 13307 requires that before the nominating period opens the district board must determine whether a charge shall be levied against each candidate submitting a candidate's statement to be sent to the voters; may estimate the cost; and determine whether the costs be paid in advance; and

WHEREAS, Elections Code Section 12112 requires the election official of the principal county to publish a notice of the election once in a newspaper of general circulation in the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED that an election be held within the territory included in this district on the 8th day of November, 2022, for the purpose of electing members to the Board of Directors of said District in accordance with the following specifications:

SPECIFICATIONS OF THE ELECTION ORDER

1. The Election shall be held on Tuesday, the 8th day of November 2022. The purpose of the election is to choose members of the Board of Directors for the following seats:

Town of Discovery Bay	Term of Office
Board of Director	12/2/2022 to 12/4/2026
Board of Director	12/2/2022 to 12/4/2026
Board of Director	12/2/2022 to 12/4/2026

2. The District has determined that the Candidate will pay for the Candidate's Statement. As a

condition of having the Candidate's Statement published, the candidate shall pay the costs at the time of filing. The District hereby estimates the cost for a candidate statement as the following: \$353.76.

- **3.** The District directs that the County Registrar of Voters of the principal county publish the Notice of Election in a newspaper of general circulation that is regularly circulated in the territory.
- **4.** This Board hereby requests and consents to the consolidation of this election with other elections which may be held in whole or in part of the territory of the district, pursuant to Elections Code 10400.
- **5.** The district will reimburse the county for the actual cost incurred by the county elections official in conducting the general district election upon receipt of a bill stating the amount due as determined by the elections official.
- **6.** The Clerk of this Board is ordered to deliver copies of this Resolution, to the Registrar of Voters, and if applicable, to the Registrar of Voters of any other county in which the election is to be held, and to the Board of Supervisors.
