1. December 20, 2018 Regular Water and Wastewater Committee DRAFT meeting minutes – Approved.

D. PRESENTATIONS

1. Water and Wastewater Update

District Engineer Harris – Provided details regarding the 4 Wastewater Projects – Master Plan, O&M Manual (Stantec - chapters are being completed), Wastewater Permit renewal (NPDES) every 5 years - strategy for Denitrification. The NPDES renewal deadline is February 1st. There was discussion regarding build out, flows, and the permit expiration of July 2019. Diffuser Project (plugged up) Contractor is Worley Parsons. There was discussion regarding the Diffuser Project recommended option of number 4.

E. DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. Update Regarding Control Panels for Lift Stations.

Project Manager Sadler – Provided handouts and an update regarding the Control Panels for Lift Stations. There was discussion regarding the Lift Station current control panel (original panels in existence for 40 plus years), working 6 to 8 months on the panels and completion possible done this summer. Once installed Project Manager Sadler will provide a presentation with the update.

2. Update Regarding Well 4A and Well 2.

Water and Wastewater Manager Koehne – Provided handouts and update regarding Well 4A and Well 2 related to rusted pipes (Well 4A), drawings. There was discussion regarding Well 4A and Well 2 related to options (\$50,000) that will be brought back to the Board, corrosion of the pipes, and the flow of water from Well 4A (originally installed in the mid 90s)
