E. DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. Discussion regarding Wastewater Treatment Plant Update and Veolia Letter regarding the Filtration Project.

General Manager Davies – Provided a background of the Wastewater Treatment Plant regarding the Filtration Project.

District Engineer Harris – Provided additional details related to the Filtration Project; operational issues with the filtration process (with the algae), pressure drop due to a faulty sensor. The Filter is back and operating properly.

Project Manager Sadler – Provided details regarding long term solutions. There was discussion regarding the algae, the lagoons, cleaning the algae out of the clarifiers, Parkson providing steps to locate and treat the problems of algae. The discussion continued related to being proactive, the response to the letter, the NOV (Notice of Violation) regarding the Snail Event, the Permit guidelines, and becoming a Title 22 Plant (January of 2023).

2. Discussion regarding Well 4A Rehab.

District Water Engineer Shobe – Provided a brief update regarding the testing of the water supply; results from the testing is that Well 4A is declining in capacity, recommend a rehab of Well 4A, prepare the bid documents (mid to late summer). There was discussion regarding Well 4A rehab.

3. Discussion regarding Luhdorff and Scalmanini General Services Contract Cost Overrun.

General Manager Davies – Provided a brief overview related to the Water Meter Installation Project with the General Services Contract.

District Water Engineer Shobe – Provided additional details regarding the cost with the General Services, final deliverables, the meter project (resident inspections), and the tracking of the costs. There was discussion regarding how to inform the residents of the meter installation charges (basic cost) and provide additional documents if requested by resident.

General Manager Davies – Provided the details regarding the General Services Contract with Luhdorff and Scalmanini that will be on the agenda for the next board meeting of March 7, 2018.
