## Community AED's Save Lives!

- Cardiovascular Disease is the leading cause of death for adults over 40 year old
- Approximately 250,000 deaths per year outside of the hospital setting are caused by Coronary Artery Disease
- In many of these cases, a person collapses and demonstrates an abnormal heart rhythm, either Ventricular Fibrillation or Ventricular Tachycardia
- ► This is where Automated External Defibrillators are crucial for a patients potential survival!

# AED Programs Improve Survival

According to the American Heart Association-"Communities with comprehensive AED programs that include CPR and AED training have achieved survival rates of nearly 40% for cardiac arrest victims"



## What Can We Do Together?

- ECCFPD and the Town of Discovery Bay work together to find solutions to acquire more AEDs for the community. This would include training and education.
- Bring in outside partners like AMR to assist in this project
- Look for additional grants and funding sources for project
- Get community groups to support and assist implementation
- Target locations and facilities that would benefit from having AED's
- Get AED locations into PulsePoint
- Set goals for implementation once we define the program objectives.


#### What is PulsePoint?

- PulsePoint is a free app for mobile devices that was created to help public agencies improve cardiac arrest survival rates by notifying members of the public, who are CPR trained, of nearby incidents.
- PulsePoint also allows citizens to be aware of other incidents in their area.
- ▶ At this time, CPR incident notification is only working for "public places"- PulsePoint is working on legal issues for CPR incident notifications for private residences. HIPPA.....



#### PulsePoint AED

- A separate, free mobile app that allows for cataloging AED's in the community
- With the app, citizens can enter and snap a picture of the AED in the community and provide information on its location
- Local authorities (ECCFPD) then verify the location and the AED becomes part of the system
- Currently all AED's in Discovery Bay are listed confirmed in the app
- ► The ECC website has a form to let us know about AEDs so we can assist the public in logging the AEDs with PulsePoint
