**General Manager/Administration:**

- ✓ I spoke with Jeff Conway at Rec. 800 on Wednesday to get an update on the status of the clams that have invaded and blocked a number of Rec 800's siphon lines and County storm drains in the area of Sand Point Road and Discovery Bay Blvd. Rec 800's contractor should be finishing up today. As I understand it, they have removed quite a few loads of clams and one large plastic inflatable plastic raft. Once they complete the process they will CCTV the lines and put their siphons back into service. The contractor had a pretty impressive array of equipment, as can be seen in the photo below:



- ✓ There continues to be a lot of discussion about the drought. As we noted to the Board at Wednesday night's meeting, we reached 45% conservation for the Month of May. Pretty astonishing figures. I'd venture to guess that not many other districts have reached that level of conservation. Once figures are all submitted in mid-June we'll have a clearer indication of just where we stand overall.

- ✓ The Board room at the Community Center is starting to look like a real Board room! The Town seal went up today.
